

Sports Team Eligibility for GKT Clubs and Non-GKT Students

This policy aims to preserve the identity of GKT student clubs at Kings College London in their BUCS competition and any internal competitions such as the Macadam Cup. From the 2013-14 season Kings College London is entered into BUCS competition as one institution with GKT teams identified in brackets (GKT). This policy will detail which students are eligible to represent which teams.

1. Any students affiliated to the faculties listed below will be considered, by KCLSU, to be a 'GKT' Student and will be extended the privileges detailed in this policy:


- Dental Institute
- Life Sciences & Medicine
- Nursing & Midwifery
- Psychiatry, Psychology & Neuroscience

2. All students in the aforementioned schools can play for a Kings College London (GKT) team. They are also eligible to represent a Kings College London team. GKT students are extended the privilege to choose who they compete for due to their schools affiliation to Kings College London.

3. Students who do not study in the schools stated in 1. are only eligible to join a GKT team if they present written confirmation (a template letter can be found on the KCLSU running a club page under BUCS) from a committee member of team captain of the club they wish to join to a student centre who will manually enter them.

4. In order to uphold this eligibility KCLSU will put in place parameters that prevent any non GKT student from purchasing membership to a GKT Team through our website. Rules have been created, on our membership system that only lets students affiliated to the aforementioned faculties purchase membership to GKT clubs.

5. Any GKT student who joins a GKT team cannot then, in the same academic year, join a Kings College London team. For example a GKT student cannot be both a member of a GKT Rugby team and a Kings College London Rugby team.



6. Once a GKT student purchases a membership to either a GKT or non GKT team they have in effect locked their allegiance to that team for the year. They are unable to switch from a Kings College London team to a GKT team or vice versa during that academic year.

7. At the beginning of each year GKT students are again free to choose which team they join but point 6. will still apply, for example in year 1 a GKT student could play for a GKT team, and in year 2 could play for a Kings College London Team.

8. Any sport that doesn't have a GKT team as designated by KCLSU & BUCS can be joined by any student.

9. KCLSU reserve the right to carry out random checks, whether at BUCS matches or Macadam Cup to ensure the policy is upheld.
