1. Academic/Co-Curricular Experience – Widening Participation ('sticky campus' project with KCLWP and Harvard) where we had focus groups with commuter students around making our campuses more 'sticky'. Since starting I have also been built upon the Denmark Hill space development as well as entered discussions around St. Thomas space development as well. Worked with new VP Education of the College around implementation of the Education Strategy. Lead officer on Digital Transformation Project within the union, as we have seen huge strides in our engagement numbers, I have been really keen for us to build upon that so we are revolutionising the website, developing our own app and transforming our physical spaces to become more digital as well! Finally, been pushing hugely for increased faculty transparency in all their works.
2. Financial Support for Students – equality impact assessment development for all big pieces of college work. Hardship funds and bursaries review to increase access and usage. Ensured consistent student representation on SMWG and greater seniority. Co-led Slice The Price campaign for all self-funding students. Co-wrote a paper on financial transparency and committed the College to undertaking a financial transparency project whereby we can see where money is spent and how much. Campaigning for increased part-time work for our students with KCL Careers. Also met with lord economic affairs committee around tuition fees.
3. Mental Health Strategy - I kick-started (a truly overdue) centralised mental health steering group with a real focus on the IoPPN as a lead player in this arena. Key stakeholders are invited to the central steering group, where we audit all our mental health services and discuss any proposed changes to services. We have set out the infrastructure of this group and decided the relevant sub-committees and some great things are being pushed through already. This is looking hugely promising and I am really proud of how everyone has pulled together so seamlessly to deliver this!
